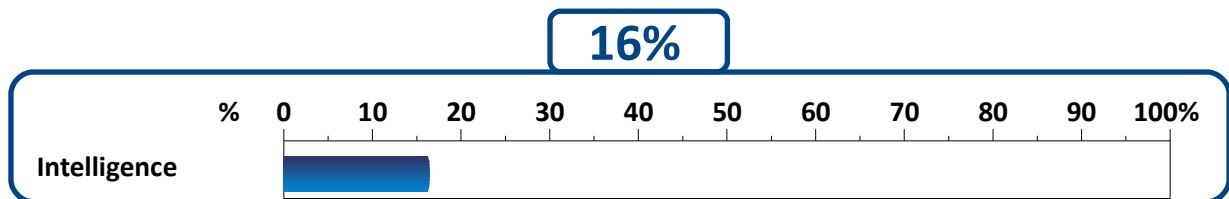
ADAPTIVE INTELLIGENCE TEST RESULTS

ABOUT THIS TEST

This test measures the ability to recognise rules and connections between unknown and seemingly random information. This ability is one of the main component of General Intelligence and as such it can greatly help the candidate in solving problems in a wide variety of situations. Because of its generic nature this ability predicts performance in life well. Because this is a non-verbal test results of test takers with different language and cultural background remain comparable.

ABOUT THE RESULTS OF THE TEST TAKER

Jane Doe's performance on this test indicates an ability which is higher than **16%** of the more than 10'000 test takers in the comparison group (while 84% performed better than her). In practice this means that Jane Doe is probably **somewhat less capable** to recognise rules and connections between new and seemingly random information and this may **occasionally hinder** her in solving problems in a wide variety of tasks in life.
